New requests are coming in all the time. They appear to be past the basic food & water phase. Electricity has not been fully restored, although they are at about 90%. I am updating the list every couple of days at this point. The current list of relief supplies needed include:

**Hundreds of Roof Tarps**

(12' x 20' and larger) - (The Larger the Better)

Generators

5 gal Gasoline Cans

(we can get them filled on the way to LA)

Extension Cords

Rags, Cleaning Supplies, Disinfectant

Mold & Mildew Killer

Work Gloves & Rubber Gloves

Flashlights

Candles

Batteries (D, C, AA, AAA, 9v)

Battery powered Fans

Chain Saw Expendables

(Chain Oil, Sharpening Files, Fuel-Oil Mix)

Shovels, Rakes, and other Clean-Up Tools

Insect Repellent and Basic First-Aid Items

Lg Trash/Garbage Bags

Plastic Sheathing

Lg Plastic Storage Boxes w/Lids

Baby Diapers

Baby Wipes & Ointments

Baby Formula

Sheets & Blankets

Folding Cots, Pillows
