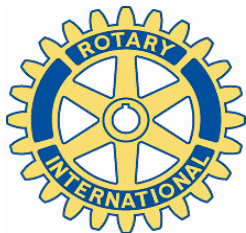

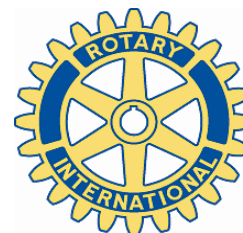
## THE OBJECT OF ROTARY
